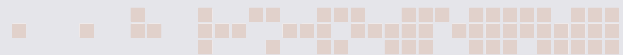

Whether you're buying an L300 to carry passengers or to transport your cargo, you can rest assured that the L300 will make it as easy as possible.

Its height and width mean that loading passengers or cargo is as comfortable as possible. Check out the dimensions of both the Long Wheel Base and Short Wheel Base models for yourself.





The L300 has a tight turning radius for easy manoeuvrability. Just 4.5 metres for the Short Wheel Base and 4.9 metres for the Long Wheel Base.

The instrumentation is easy to read with great all-round visibility. The Short Wheel Base van comes with three or six seat configurations.

The rear bumper has a built-in step. The load area is vinyl lined to help protect your cargo. It also has four cargo tie-down points built in.



## 16-VALVE PETROL POWER

All petrol engines have 16-valve technology for increased load-carrying power and safer passing acceleration.

The easy breathing efficiency and improved fuel/air mix of 16-valve technology result in more powerful combustion, offering 97KW of power and 192Nm of torque.

All petrol L300s have fuel-injected 2.4-litre 16-valve engines which deliver outstanding performance.

The electronically controlled Mitsubishi fuel injection system (ECI multi-point) is quite remarkable. It has its own powerful computer that calculates the correct fuel/air mixture the engine needs for maximum fuel efficiency in all driving conditions (fast, slow, loaded, high humidity, high altitude etc). It means you get more power from less fuel.

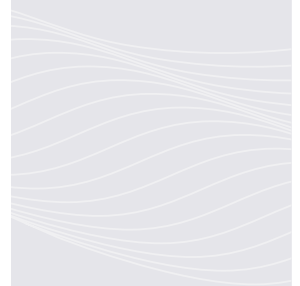


## L300 TURBO DIESEL TORQUE

Mitsubishi's turbo leadership is recognised worldwide. It's a reputation built on exceptional turbo performance and long-lasting reliability. Put your foot down and you'll experience smooth turbo performance right through the power curve. And because the turbo is perfectly matched to the 2.5-litre engine, you get the maximum possible benefit in power, torque and economy.

The smoothness of this Mitsubishi diesel results from unique "Silent Shafts" deep inside the engine that minimise vibration. And if you think diesels are noisy, wait until you drive the L300. Advanced Mitsubishi fuel injector design has brought the clatter level right down.

While per-litre cost alone makes diesel a serious alternative, the practical advantage of the diesel's turbo-powered load-carrying torque is equally important. With 201Nm of on-the-ground torque, it is stronger than some bigger capacity diesels available.





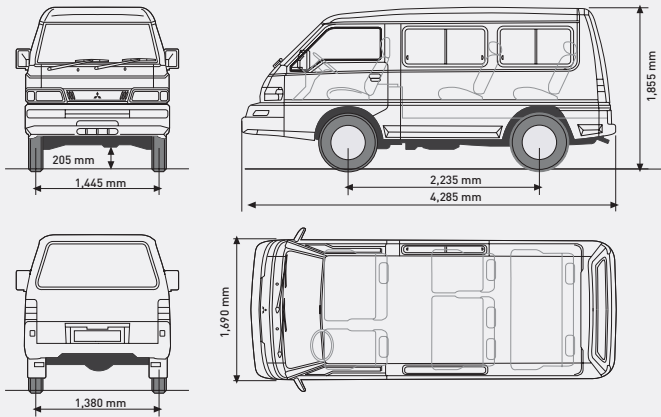

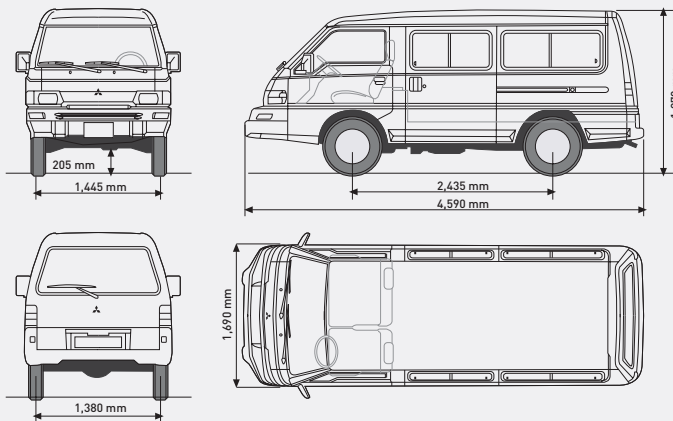

> **MITSUBISHI WARRANTY**

The Mitsubishi Warranty gives you three-year/100,000 km bumper-to-bumper protection. The comprehensive cover includes corrosion perforation and even Mitsubishi accessories like the vehicle audio system.

Your warranty is transferable, so if you sell the vehicle within three years/100,000 km, the new owner can continue to enjoy peace of mind for the remainder of the period.

> **MITSUBISHI EXTENDED WARRANTY**

Extended warranties are available at the time of purchase at very competitive rates. You can extend the standard three-year/100,000 km Mitsubishi Warranty by anything from 12 to 36 months.

> **MITSUBISHI SERVICE**

Your first service at one month/1500 km is free. After that, Mitsubishi L300 requires servicing every 5000 km (diesel) or 10,000 km (petrol).

> **FINANCE MITSUBISHI**

Paying cash is just one of the ways to purchase a Mitsubishi. There is a range of finance options that make ownership easier – you should explore them with your Mitsubishi Motors dealer.
